

2. In the Punjab State Agricultural Marketing Board (Class-II) Service Rules, 1988, in Appendix 'B', against serial No. 6, under column 5, after the words and sign "three years", the following paras shall be added, namely :—

"In the event of non-availability of eligible Planning Assistants, then from amongst the Draftsmen working in the Board who possess a Post Graduate Degree or Diploma in City and Regional Planning or its equivalent or Associate Member of Institute of Architects and who have an experience of working on the posts of Draftsman and Junior Draftsman for a minimum period of ten years.

In the event of non-availability of eligible Planning Assistants and Draftsmen, then, from amongst the Junior Draftsmen working in the Board who possess a Post Graduate Degree or Diploma in City and Regional Planning or its equivalent or Associate Member of Institute of Architects and who have an experience of working as Junior Draftsman for minimum period of twelve years."

No. 11/12/07-M (3)/7194.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 43 of the Punjab Agricultural Produce Markets Act, 1961 (Punjab Act 23 of 1961), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab Agricultural Produce Markets (General) Rules, 1962, namely :—

RULES

1. These rules may be called the Punjab Agricultural Produce Markets (General) (Second Amendment), Rules, 2007.

2. In the Punjab Agricultural Produce Markets (General) Rules, 1962, in rule 21, after sub-rule (3), the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:—

(3-A) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (3), the period of six months, commencing with effect from the 1st day of April, 2007 to the 30th day of September, 2007, shall be deemed to be allowed as a grace period for getting the licences renewed for the year 2007-08 as a special case."
