(5)/2001.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 43 of the Punjab Agricultural Produce Markets Act, 1961 (Punjab Act 23 of 1961), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab State Agricultural Marketing Board (Engineering Wing) Execution of Works Rules, 1979, namely:—

RULES

1. These rules may be called Punjab State Agricultural Marketing Board (Engineering Wing) Execution of Works (First Amendment) Rules, 2001.

2. In the Punjab State Agricultural Marketing Board (Engineering Wing) Execution of Works Rules 1979 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in rule 2, in clause (g) the words "as well as of the Committees" shall be omitted.

3. In the said rules, in rule 3,—

(i) in sub-rule (3), in clause (xvii), the words "or the Committees" shall be omitted;

(ii) in sub-rule (4), for the words and signs "financial provisions; irrespective of the fact whether such works are financed by the Board or by the Committees," the words and sign "financial provisions", shall be substituted; and

(iii) in sub-rule (7), for the words "all such works irrespective of the fact whether such works are financed by the Board or by the Committee or deposit works or any other works taken up by the Board for execution", the words "works taken by the Board" shall be substituted.

4. In the said rules, for rule 4, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:—

"4. Execution of works.—The market Committee concerned shall be responsible for execution of works financed by the committee through itself, through Panchayats or through Construction Wing of the Mandi Board or through Government/Public Agency".



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5. In the said rules, in rule 10, for sub-rule(1) and note thereunder the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“(1) The concerned Executive Engineer will prepare a rough cost estimate and get it scrutinized from the Drawing Branch of his office and send the same to the Chairman, Market Committee for according administrative approval. Whenever the cost of estimate exceeds the powers of Executive Engineer then the estimate will be submitted to Superintending Engineer/Chief Engineer and after scrutiny in the Drawing Branch of Chief Engineer, the estimate will be sent to the Chairman of the Market Committee by the Chief Engineer or Superintending Engineer as per their competency for according the Administrative Approval if the funds are to be deposited by the Market Committee. In case the work is to be financed by the Mandi Board, the same shall be sent through Chief Engineer to the Secretary to the Board. The Administrative Approval when accorded by the Chairman of the Market Committee or the Secretary of the Board, as the case may be, would be directive to the Competent Authority to go ahead with the work and a clear financial sanction to incur expenditure to the extent of amount of the estimate, by debit to the Marketing Development Fund of the Board or the Market Committee Fund of the Committee concerned, as the case may be.

Note.— While endorsing Administrative Approval to the Executive Engineer concerned, the Chairman, Market Committee or Secretary, Mandi Board if required, will send copies thereof to the Executive Engineer Electrical and the Executive Engineer Public Health, conveying estimated provisions approval for parts of the works to be undertaken by them.”

6. In the said rules, in rule 14, for the words “Chief Engineer” wherever occurring, the words “Competent Authority” shall be substituted.
